1. 7:1-6 What does the marriage metaphor teach us about: a) Our relationship to the law? b) Our relationship to Christ? (Hint: How does the metaphor continue to answer the question of 6:15 – “Are Christians now free to live as they choose?”)
2. vv.7-8 Which Biblical commandment seems to have “slain” Paul? Why would a Pharisee like Paul be so convicted by it?
3. In v 19 Paul discloses his experience in warfare with sin. How does this both warn us and comfort us?
