Adult Sunday School Classes:

What Did Jesus Do? – Understanding the Work of Christ (New Class)

(Video Series) by R.C. Sproul

When Jesus approached John the Baptist to be baptized, John initially objected. But Jesus responded by saying that it was necessary "to fulfill all righteousness" (Matt. 3:15). Why was this act and others like it so important? Most Christians understand the importance of Christ's atoning sacrifice and the significance of his resurrection. But how many comprehend the significance of the life Jesus led prior to the crowning weeks of the passion? In this teaching series, R.C. Sproul uncovers what it means for Christ to be the "second Adam" and what this means for believers today.

The Gospel of John (Two Classes See below)

The book of John is one of the most unique and beautiful books of the New Testament. John is very different from the other three Gospels in his storytelling, his style, and even his perspective. The contrast is such that scholars call the other three the "Synoptic Gospels", coming from a Greek word that means "able to be seen together." The others have many of the same stories in the same order, sometimes even using the same wording, while John's Gospel is in a world all it's own. Over 90% of John's Gospel is original material not found in the other three. Yet John 20:31 states, "But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name." John Calvin remarks, "The synoptics show us Jesus' life, John's Gospel show us Jesus' heart."
